ORGANIZER:

EC LiWoddruck Spittal Hornets

GAME MODE:

Matchfield: cross field

Playing time: U8 – 18 min. gross playing time
U10 – 18 min. gross playing time

Change interval / 1 minute - horn signal / flying change

Team-Information for all age groups:

ELIGIBILITY:

Children in the year 2012 and younger are eligible to play in the U8.

Over Age regulation:

Girls and goalie of the year 2011 are in the age group U8, also eligible to play

Eligible to play in the U10 are children of the year 2010 and younger.

Over Age regulation:

Girls and goalkeepers of the vintage 2009 are in the age group U10, also entitled to play.

FOOD:

On day 1, all teams including coaches and max. 2 supervisors a warm are provided one meal and on day 2 a snack.

Food stamps will be handed over to the team manager at the start of the tournament (two food stamps per player, coach and maximum 2 supervisors).

Each food stamp entitles to the consumption of one meal.

These meals are included in the registration fee.

ACCOMMODATION:

Cost of accommodation must be borne and organized by the teams themselves. We are happy to offer you our partner companies with our conditions.

MODE:

Play time is gross time - time is running through.

It is played in two groups, each against each within the groups.

Overall, each team denies 4 games in the basic round.

On the final day after the placings cross games are performed and thus the final placements played out. The team at table position 5, after the basic round, will play one game on the final day, all other teams two games.

If a goal is scored, the successful block must be behind the centerline or high five your own goalkeeper. The goalkeeper of the team, who had to accept a goal, puts the disc behind his goal and the game is continued by his teammates without interruption.

The team strength is at least 3 blocks:

U8 at least 12 players plus goalie

U10 at least 9 players plus goalie

GROUP U8

4 vs 4 players plus goalie

The outfielders are to be entered in the match report consecutively (without consideration of the position), giving the number of the back. The match reports are to be delivered to the tournament management until 15 minutes before the start of the match.

The blocks may not be changed during the game, the substitutes may only be changed within their blocks.

The blocks are to be inserted alternately in turn.

An injured player can be replaced with a player from the after block for the entire game, if no substitute is provided in his block. The change of the goalkeeper is possible with each change.

The teams must be ready each 5 minutes before the start of the game.

No warm up on the ice. Blue play puck, goals reduced.

GROUP U10

3 vs 3 players plus goalie

The outfielders are to be entered in the match report consecutively (without consideration of the position), giving the number of the back. The match reports are to be delivered to the tournament management until 15 minutes before the start of the match.

The blocks may not be changed during the game, the substitutes may only be changed within their blocks.

The blocks are to be inserted alternately in turn.

An injured player can be replaced with a player from the after block for the entire game, if no substitute is provided in his block. The change of the goalkeeper is possible with each change.

The teams must be ready each 5 minutes before the start of the game.

Black play puck, goals regular

JERSEYS:

All teams are asked to wear two differently colored jersey sets brought along.

REFEREES:

All games are conducted in the „1-man system“, in the finals two referees are used.

PENALTIES:

A foul gives the fouled team a penaltyshot.

The game continues with a face off at the center line.

A Game Misconduct penalty will result in a game suspension for the corresponding player. A match penalty automatically means the immediate exclusion of the rest of the tournament for that player.

NOTE TO DISCIPLINARY PENALTIES:

Players who commit a bad foul - exaggerated severity or unsportsmanlike conduct are directed by the referee from the game - Penalty: Penalty.

After the match, the Tournament Director, in consultation with the referee, reserves the right to block the player for several matches or to exclude him from the tournament.

In addition, in some cases entire teams may be eliminated from the tournament if they display disrespectful behavior towards umpires, tournament directors or opponents or bad behavior.

STANDINGS:

In the basic round you get 3 points for a win and 1 point for a draw.

In case of equality of points after the basic round, the ranking takes place:

- Direct game of the same score teams

With several teams a table of the games is created against each other.

- Better goal difference
- Number of goals scored
- Lot of decision

On the final day, all matches in a draw after the regular season in the penalty shootout decided. There are 3 players from each team, if the result is still undecided after three penalties, the process continues with a „tiebreaker“.

ARBITRATION:

In disputes, the organizer, as well as coaches and team captains of each team form the arbitration committee. The representatives of the affected team are eliminated.

AWARD CEREMONY:

The award ceremony will take place immediately after the finals on the ice. It is requested that all teams participate in the award ceremony. The teams should appear without skates, but with the player jerseys on the ice.

CHOICE FOR THE BEST PLAYER AND GOALIE IN THE FINALS:

The choice of the best player and goalkeeper in the category U8 and U10 will be announced by the tournament management immediately after the final match.

MEDICAL CORPS:

Medical service and first aid is provided by the organizer.

The respective clubs must take over the costs for the hospital or transport to the hospital itself in case of accident or illness of its participants.

LIABILITY:

The organizer assumes no liability for illness, stolen or lost valuables and any injuries. If the injured person is not insured or his home country does not have an agreement for medical care with Austria, the participant in the tournament must bear the costs of the treatment himself.

The necessary insurance companies bear the individual clubs.
